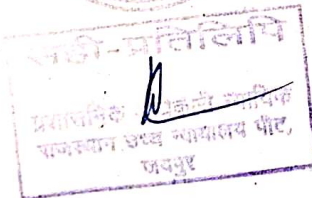

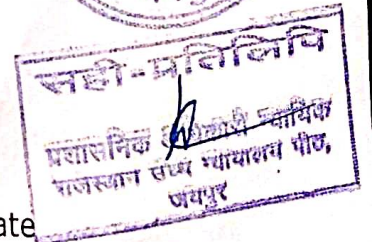

**HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE ANIL KUMAR UPMAN**

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the private respondents have issued a clear and open call for a mass gathering on 30.03.2026 at the petitioner's village, and one of the site for this mass gathering is petitioner's residence. Counsel

submits that this call has been made under the garb of a criminal investigation in FIR No.703/2025 registered at Police Station Mathuragate, District Bharatpur. Counsel further submits that the private respondents are conducting a parallel media trial through social media by widely circulating false and misleading content, emails and videos thereby inciting the public to assemble unlawfully at the residences of the accused persons named in the criminal investigation. Counsel submits that such actions are impermissible in law and create a serious apprehension of public disorder, as the possibility of the assembly turning violent cannot be ruled out.

2. In view of above, issue notice to the respondents.
3. Learned State counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Copy of this petition has already been supplied in the office of learned State Counsel.
4. Let notice be issued to the respondent Nos.4 to 8, through both the process, returnable on next date of hearing. Requisites be filed within a period of two weeks.
5. Meanwhile, respondent Nos.2 and 3 are directed to ensure that no harm is caused to the family members of the petitioner and no *Dharna* or demonstration shall be held at the house or in front of the house of the petitioner without prior permission of the administration. They are further directed to maintain law and order in the area.
6. List this case after six weeks.
